INFORMATION ABOUT OUR USE OF COOKIES

- 1. Our website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our website. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our website and also allows us to improve our website.
- 2. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that we store on your browser or the hard drive of your computer if you agree. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive.
- 3. We use the following cookies:
 - **Analytical/performance cookies**. They allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around our website when they are using it. This helps us to improve the way our website works, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- 4. You can find more information about the individual cookies we use and the purposes for which we use them in the table below:

- 6. You block cookies by activating the setting on your browser that allows you to refuse the setting of all or some cookies. However, if you use your browser settings to block all cookies (including essential cookies) you may not be able to access all or parts of our website.
- 7. Session cookies are deleted when the browser is closed. Dated cookies are deleted upon the expiry date set, which varies depending on the cookie.
